Administrative Regulation

Employees, Tubercular Examinations Required of

Every four (4) years an employee shall furnish an examination to determine that the employee is free from active tuberculosis. The examination shall consist of the intradermal Mantoux tuberculin test. In the event of a positive test, each employee shall file with the Office of Personnel Services a report from a licensed physician showing the employee has been found free of active tuberculosis. Failure to comply with the provisions of this regulation will be considered sufficient cause for withholding the pay warrant and/or dismissal.

The Office of Personnel Services shall advise each regular employee of the date of the next required test for tuberculosis. This notice will usually be given well in advance of the due date. However, the ultimate responsibility for knowing the expiration date of a given tuberculin test period rests with the employee.
