

BOARD POLICY

Cafeteria/Food ServicesGeneral Operations

The district shall provide food services at all schools of the district in compliance with the Education Code.

As permitted by the Education Code, official guests of school employees are permitted to use the food services program at the same price as school employees.

The district will participate in the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program as required by the Education Code.

The use of student helpers in the cafeteria is authorized if adequate safeguards as to their health and safety are provided, as required by state law.

School cafeterias and food services may provide banquets, luncheons, or other food or catering services to groups not connected with the school only as authorized by the Board of Education, superintendent, or designee. When such services are provided, a charge shall be made to cover all expenses incurred.

Records and Confidentiality

All applications and records related to eligibility for the free or reduced price meal program shall be confidential except as provided by law.

In accordance with law, the Board authorizes designated employees as identified in Administrative Regulation 2150.1 to use individual records pertaining to student eligibility for any free and reduced price meal program for the purpose of:

1. Disaggregation of academic achievement data.
2. Identification of students eligible for school choice and supplemental educational services in any school identified for program improvement.
