

BOARD POLICY

Alternative Instruction/Training, Position Statement

The Board of Education recognizes that high school age students can benefit from and should be afforded the opportunity for alternative instruction and/or training as approved and established at various programs both within and outside the district.

Therefore, courses in Adult Education, Adult Education Independent Learning, Continuation Education, Regional Occupational Programs, School Age Parenting Education, Vocational and Work Experience, as well as classes in post secondary institutions, shall be open to qualified students of the district, as prescribed by administrative regulation.
