Graduation Requirements, Specific Provisions of

To fulfill the requirements for a diploma from any day high school in the district, students must: (1) complete 152.5 credits in the stipulated required curriculum; (2) complete 67.5 credits in elective courses as part of the prescribed 220 credits for graduation; (3) and successfully complete Algebra 1.

A. Required Curriculum	152.5 credits
Fine and/or Applied Arts.....	10 credits
English	40 credits
History/Social Science.....	30 credits
Health Education	2.5 credits
Mathematics	30 credits
Physical Education	20 credits
Science.....	20 credits

B. Elective Courses 67.5 credits

A Board-approved sequence of elective courses offered by each school provides instruction to assure every student an opportunity to acquire skills required for entry level employment, continued education, or both.

Total 220 credits

All students shall be made aware of the graduation requirements adopted by the Board.

C. Early Graduation Procedures

In those special instances where graduation from a day high school is anticipated with less than eight regular semesters of attendance, a petition (Form 9806.26) shall be completed by the student with the aid and advice of the respective counselor and forwarded to the administrator of secondary education for approval or denial.
