

BOARD POLICY

Sex Offender Information and Notification

According to state law, it is the responsibility of local law enforcement agencies to assess the relative danger of registered sex offenders who may reside or work in the community, and to notify the public upon determination of risk presented by such individuals.

The Board of Education believes that it is important for the district to respond appropriately when law enforcement agencies notify the district with information concerning registered sex offenders who may reside or work within district boundaries.

The superintendent or the designated representative shall maintain ongoing communication with law enforcement officials to coordinate the receipt and dissemination of such information.

The superintendent shall develop an appropriate administrative regulation and other necessary procedures to implement this policy.
