

BOARD POLICY

Equipment Loaned to or by the District, Restrictions on

1. Equipment Loaned by the District

No equipment, materials, or supplies of any nature that are the property of the district are to be loaned to outside organizations for use away from the school premises.

2. Equipment Loaned to the District

No furniture or equipment of a large, expensive nature shall be loaned, given, or deposited at any school without first obtaining the approval of the superintendent or the designated representative. Equipment which is needed for instructional purposes shall be purchased by the district, unless such equipment is made a gift to the school district, such gift being subject to the acceptance of the Board of Education. Nothing in this policy shall be construed to prevent a teacher from bringing small items for display or other instructional use which would enrich curricular offerings.
