BOARD POLICY

Student Health Examinations/Screenings

- A. The Board of Education recognizes that periodic health examinations/screenings of students may lead to the detection and treatment of conditions that impact learning and also may help in determining whether special adaptations of the school program are necessary.
- B. In addition to verifying that students have complied with legal requirements for health examinations and immunizations before enrolling in school, the district shall administer tests for vision, hearing, and scoliosis as required by law.
- C. All students who participate as cheerleaders, song leaders, or athletes in organized competitive sports shall first undergo and file with the district a current medical examination report.
- D. Staff employed to examine students shall exercise proper care that each student's results are kept confidential. Records related to these examinations shall be available only in accordance with law.
