

## BOARD POLICY

Suspensions; Parent or Guardian to Attend Portion of School Day

Provisions of the California Education Code provide that a teacher may suspend a student from class under certain conditions and for specific reasons.

A teacher who suspends a student from class because the student committed an obscene act or engaged in habitual profanity or vulgarity, or disrupted school activities, or otherwise willfully defied school personnel, may make a written request of the school principal to require the parent or guardian of the suspended student to attend a portion of the school day in the child's classroom.

The superintendent shall develop appropriate administrative regulations and other necessary procedures to implement this policy as set forth in the code.
